Wim Wenders explores pristine landscapes in his new documentary, "The Salt of the Earth," about the photojournalist Sebastião Salgado. Here, he recalls his own memorable brush with the great outdoors.

During a trip through the Australian outback, I spent every night under the desert sky. On one particular morning, I woke up at dawn and stumbled out of my sleeping bag in my underwear, eager to photograph the purity of the morning sunlight. After weeks and weeks of sleeping outside, I had problems getting used to hotel rooms again. It got so bad that upon my return to Sydney, I found a hotel with a big balcony so I could drag the mattress out at night. I just couldn't sleep with a roof over me.
